Turfgrass Management

Offered only in Fall

In this noncredit workshop, emphasis is placed on turfgrass growth and development, use and adaptability, and pests. Major weed, insect, and disease pests in Maryland will be discussed. Primary cultural practices including fertilization, mowing, and irrigation will also be covered. **Cost: \$450, plus textbooks.**

Insects of Ornamentals and Turfgrass

Offered only in Fall

This noncredit workshop covers the major pests and beneficial insects of ornamental plants and turfgrasses in the Mid-Atlantic region. Students will be responsible for insect identification, life history, and control practices of approximately 100 insects. **Cost: \$400, plus textbooks.**

Pesticide Use & Safety

Offered in Spring and Fall

This noncredit workshop provides an overview of pesticide use and safety. Topics include environmental protection, labeling, personal safety, first aid, formulation and chemistry, equipment, disposal, storage, record-keeping, and liability. The course prepares students for the Maryland private applicator's license. **Cost: \$400, plus textbooks.**
